APHA Briefing Note 22/26

Guidance on the certification of the attestation regarding antimicrobial medicinal products for exports to the European Union

Date issued: 30th July 2026

Purpose

To advise Official Veterinarians and Food Competent Certifying Officers on certification of the attestation regarding antimicrobial medicinal products for Products Of Animal Origin (POAO) and some live animal Export Health Certificates used for exports to the European Union.

Background

From 3 September 2026, the attestation regarding antimicrobial medicinal products as regards Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2023/905 must be certified where the European Union is the final destination, regardless of the date of production (in the case of POAO).

For POAO obtained from food-producing animals in the UK and for live animals originating in the UK, the attestation may be certified on the basis of the UK Veterinary Medicines Regulations, the UK Maximum Residue Limit legal framework, and Great Britain's listing in the relevant EU third-country list.

Certifying Officers should note that Implementing Regulation (EU) 2024/2598, to which the attestation refers, has been repealed and replaced by Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2026/1189. The relevant third-country list is now contained in Annex XVIa of Implementing Regulation (EU) 2021/405, as amended.

The list of affected Export Health Certificates can be found below in Annex 1.

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Notes for Guidance for the affected certificates will be updated in due course.

Action

From 3 September 2026, Certifying Officers must ensure that the attestation regarding antimicrobial medicinal products is certified where the EU is the final destination of the consignment.

For UK-origin POAO and live animals, certification may be supported by the UK legal framework and GB's EU listing status.

Where a consignment contains POAO obtained from non-EU third-country origin animals, including products used as ingredients, further processed in GB, or already stored in GB before the requirement applies, the Certifying Officer must be satisfied that the products comply with the antimicrobial medicinal products attestation.

Exporters must provide sufficient traceability evidence to demonstrate that any non-EU third-country-origin POAO or live animals come from a country or region listed for the relevant product or animal in Annex XVIa of Implementing Regulation (EU) 2021/405, as amended.
